Answer is Behcets disease and pathergy test. Pathergy test is one of the diagnostic tool to identify behcets disease. **Pathergy test** induces a skin response by needleprick, with positive reactions manifesting as a papule or pustule developing by 48 hours. It's classically positive in behcets disease which manifests as recurrent oro-genital ulcers.

In tuberculosis mantoux test is done, which is an intradermal test that produces induration if positive. Whereas Allergy tests have erythema and wheal and test dose of drug is usually given at single site.

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
